Your doctor has prescribed for you Ocrevus® and you are concerned on how to get the treatment?

Roche is committed to be your trusted healthcare partner, to deliver innovative medicines to meet the needs of patients with active relapsing forms of multiple sclerosis (MS) and primary progressive multiple sclerosis (PPMS), and to make a change in their lives.

Roche*Cares* Patient Support Program (PSP) supported by Roche, in collaboration with PH360, is designed for patients with active relapsing forms of multiple sclero-sis (MS) and primary progressive multiple sclerosis (PPMS) who are prescribed Ocrevus[®] for their treatment until discontinuation.

The process will be re-assessed on a yearly basis.

Eligible patients to benefit from **Roche***Cares* patient support program should be covered by either National Social Security Fund (NSSF) or COOP (Cooperative of Government Employees), and prescribed Ocrevus® from their physician.

Roche*Cares* Patient Support Program (PSP) will offer NSSF patients 5% financial contribution from the Ocrevus[®] total cost, and will offer COOP patients 10% finan-cial contribution from the Ocrevus[®] total cost. The PSP is managed by PH360 which will offer you close monitoring and support.

PH360 support team are always available to follow-up on your treatment cycles with Ocrevus® to maximize your benefit.



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Physician prescribes Ocrevus® to the patient, informs him about the program and hands the patient an envelope which includes the PSP hotline number, program instructions and the consent form for NSSF or COOP patients (to be signed by both the physician and the patient).

After signing the consent form, patient will contact the hotline. The program manager/nurse will explain the process with all the required documents needed before going to the hospital:

Documents you need to submit to PH360 are:

- The consent form signed by the physician and patient
- Patient's medical report and physician's prescription
- NSSF ID number or COOP ID number
- Individual ID
- NSSF or COOP pre-approval (optional)

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PH360 program manager will assess your eligibility for the program within 48 hours after submitting the documents.

Eligibility:

NSSF (National social security fund – Daman) patient or COOP patients with active relapsing forms of multiple sclerosis (MS) and primary progressive multiple sclerosis (PPMS) who are prescribed Ocrevus by their physician for their treatment.

NSSF COOP

As soon as the status is approved by PH360, the program manager communicates with the patient to inform him/her of the approval. PH360 will compensate the 5% out of pocket to NSSF patients or the 10% out of pocket to the COOP patients of Ocrevus® price upon his/her discharge from the hospital for each cycle until treatment discontinuation.
